Biographical Note

Adda Alma Pierce was born in Brown County, South Dakota in October 1888. She received her teaching degree from Northern State Teachers College when she was 39 years old. Her first teaching assignment was a one room school house with five students in Huron, South Dakota. Pierce taught at a total of 14 schools before she retired from teaching in 1957. In her years of teaching she taught things such as commere, social studies, typing, and English. She followed the post-school activities on many of her students in the newspaper, and was very interested in local events such as the Snow Queen Pageant. Pierce moved back to Aberdeen in 1952 where she lived the rest of her life until her death in 1974.

Scope and Content
