## **Historical Note**

On the morning of September 11, 2001, hijackers took control of four commercial airlines and crashed two of them into the World Trade Centers in New York City and one into The Pentagon in Washington DC. The fourth crashed into a field in Shanksville, Pennsylvania. In the aftermath of the terrorist attack, media coverage of the attack was 24/7. Clark Wold collected a variety of newspapers on the attack for his own personal collection.

## **Scope and Content**

The formats in this collection include newspapers. This collection is entirely in English. It is arranged chronologically into one series, *September 11th*. This collection is made up of the five

issues of the *Aberdeen American News* that were published immediately after September 11, 2001 – September 12<sup>th</sup> to September 16<sup>th</sup>.
