Biographical Note

Gladys Fulker was born in Aberdeen in 1906. After her graduation from Lemmon, S.D. high school in 1925 she began teaching in rural South Dakotas to support herself. She attended Northern Normal and Industrial School during the summer sessions for 10 years during the Great Depression, and after her hard work she became a 1937 alumnus of Northern Normal and Industrial School, receiving her 2-year degree in Intermediate Grade Education. She went back to teaching in rural schools for the rest of her career until 1944 when she moved to Minneapolis, Minnesota with her husband where she spent the remainder of her life.
