The main objective of the club was to create more "pep" among the students at basketball, football, track meets, and other intercollegiate activities in which Northern students participated. The club also sponsored events such as formal dances. The club disbanded around 1970.

Biographical Note

Marguerite Evans was born July 15, 1901 in Groton, South Dakota. She moved with her family to Aberdeen in 1918 and completed her education at Central High School. She then obtained her degree from the Northern Normal and Industrial School and she taught in North and South Dakota and Iowa. During the summers she did Chautauqua work. In 1941, she married Roy Graham of Atlantic, Iowa. Following his death in 1948 she earned her master's degree at the University of Iowa. She then taught for two years at Lakeland, Florida before moving to Sanford where she was supervisor of speech therapy for 23 years prior to her retirement. She was a member of the Woman's Club, the Retired Teachers Association, and the Presbyterian Women's Group. She was a past president of the Business and Professional Women's Club. She died April 17, 1981 in Winter Park, Florida, where she had resided.

The organization aimed to provide an opportunity for teacher trainees in the secretarial area, expand understanding of the secretarial profession, promote a spirit of fellowship among secretarial students, and provide opportunities for contacts between students and professional business men and women. The association disbanded around 1983.
